*Alchemilla alpina*

[Synonyms : *Alchemilla alpina* subsp. *glomerata*, *Alchemilla plicatula*]

**ALPINE LADY’S-MANTLE** is a perennial. Native to Europe, Greenland and northern Asia it has tiny yellowish-green flowers.

It is also known as *Alchemille argentée* (French), *Alchemille des Alpes* (French), *Alpenfrauenmantel* (German), *Alpentaumantel* (German), *Fjälldaggkåpa* (Swedish), *Fjällkåpa* (Swedish), *Kleines Silbermänteli* (German), *Manteau de Notre-Dame* (French), Mountain lady’s-mantle, *Silbermäntel* (German), Silvery lady’s mantle, and *Tunturipoimulehti* (Finnish).

*Alpina* means ‘alpine’ ie. found above the tree line.
