Amaranthus Amaranthaceae

Amaranthus is derived from Greek a (without) and maranto (fading, withering) components with reference to the long-lasting flowers especially to love-lies-bleeding (Amaranthus caudatus).

Warning – all parts of the plant can be poisonous for some animals if eaten in quantity and can cause bloating, vitamin deficiency, gastric irritation and very occasionally death.
