Anagallis tenella

BOG PIMPERNEL is a creeping perennial. Native to western Europe (including Britain) it has small pale pink flowers.

It is also known as *Gwlyddyn Mair Gors* (Welsh), *Krypmyre* (Swedish), *Mouron délicat* (French), and *Zarter Gauchheil* (German).

Bog pimpernel flowers are larger than those of scarlet pimpernel (*Anagallis arvensis*).

Tenella is Latin (sweet and tender, delicate, little) meaning ‘delicate, dainty, tender or frail’.
