Artemisia biennis

BIENNIAL WORMWOOD is a biennial (occasionally annual). Native to North America it has greenish-yellow flowers

It is also known as Biennial sagewort, Lesser mugwort, *Pelyněk dvouletý* (Czech), Slender mugwort, and *Smalmalört* (Swedish).

Biennis means ‘biennial’.

The North American Gosiute Indians used to collect the seeds for food.

The plant is enjoyed by turkeys.

Apparently the Cherokee Indians used biennial wormwood as a source of medicine for treating period problems, wind, worms, sores and wounds.
