*Canarina canariensis*

[Synonyms : *Campanula canariensis*, *Canarina campanula*, *Canarina canariensis* var. *angustifolia*, *Canarina laevigata*, *Mindium canariense*]

**CANARY ISLAND BELLFLOWER** is a perennial climbing shrub. Native to the Canary Islands and tropical Africa it has dark reddish-veined, reddish orange flowers.

It is also known as *Bicacarea* (Canary Island), and Canary bellflower.

*Canariensis* means ‘of or from the Canary Islands’.

This climbing shrub has been cultivated in Britain since 1696 as an ornamental.
