## Canarina canariensis

[Synonyms : Campanula canariensis, Canarina campanula, Canarina canariensis var. angustifolia, Canarina laevigata, Mindium canariense]

**CANARY ISLAND BELLFLOWER** is a perennial climbing shrub. Native to the Canary Islands and tropical Africa it has dark reddish-veined, reddish orange flowers.

It is also known as *Bicacarea* (Canary Island), and Canary bellflower.

Canariensis means 'of or from the Canary Islands'.

This climbing shrub has been cultivated in Britain since 1696 as an ornamental.
