*Cardamine bulbifera*

[Synonyms : *Dentaria bulbifera*]

**CORALROOT** is a perennial. Native to Europe (including Britain, although rare there now), it has small white through pink to purple (deepening with age) flowers.

It is also known as Coralroot bittercress, Coralwort, *Dentaire* (French), *Dentaire bulbifère* (French), *Dentaria* (Italian), *Tandrot* (Swedish), Toothwort, and *Zahnwurz* (German).

Some authorities point out that the flowers can be rare.

*Bulbifera* is derived from Latin *bulbi-* (bulb) and *-fer* (bearing, carrying) components meaning ‘producing small bulbs’ with reference to those at the base of the leaflets.
