Carex digitata

FINGERED SEDGE is a sedge. Native to Europe (including Britain) it has greenish-brown flower spikelets.

It is also known as *Carex digité* (French), *Finger-Segge* (German), *Fingerstarr* (Swedish), *Osoka palčataja* (Russian), *Ostrica prstnatá* (Slovak), *Ostřice prstnatá* (Czech), *Turzyca palczasta* (Polish), and *Vispstarr* (Swedish).

The flowers are pollinated by the wind.

Digitata is derived from Latin *digiti* (finger) meaning ‘lobed like an open hand or finger-like’.
