*Centrosema virginianum*

**SPURRED BUTTERFLY PEA** is a trailing or twining perennial vine. Native to North America it has pea-like, violet flowers conspicuously spurred.

It is also known as Bluebell, Butterfly pea, Conchita, While peas, Wild blue vine, and Wild pea.

*Virginianum* means 'of or from Virginia (United States)' which itself was named after the English 'Virgin Queen' Elizabeth I (1533-1603).
