*Cerithe*

*Boraginaceae*

*Cerithe* is derived from Greek *cerō-* (wax, horn) and *anthos* (flower) components with reference to the belief that bees gathered wax from the flowers.

Apparently it was once believed that bees obtained wax from honeywort (*Cerithe major*) flowers.
