**HONEYWORT** is an annual. Native to the Mediterranean it has small, yellow flowers usually with brown markings at their base.

It is also known as Greater honeywort, *Grosse Wachsblume* (German), Large cerinthe, *Stor vaxblomma* (Swedish), *Vahakukka* (Finnish), and Yellow candy.

*Major* is derived from Latin *maior* (greater) meaning 'greater, bigger or larger'.
