Cinnamodendron corticosum

FALSE WINTER'S BARK is a tree. It is native to the West Indies, particularly Jamaica. It is also known as Mountain cinnamon, and Red canella.

Corticosum is derived from Latin *cortex* (bark, rind, shell) meaning 'heavily barked or with cork tree -like bark'.

The bark is used locally both as a spice and a medicine. In the latter capacity it offers an alternative to winter's bark (*Drimys winteri*) and is considered a treatment for colic and indigestion.
