*Cissus javana*

[Synonyms : *Cissus discolor*, *Cissus velutina*, *Vitis discolor*]

**BEGONIA TREEBINE** is a climbing vine. Native from south-eastern Asia to Australia (particularly Cambodia and Indonesian Java), it has reddish-purple beneath, shiny dark green leaves with pink, purple, violet and silver marbling and red-tinted, white flowers. It is also known as Begonia cissus, *Kirjokissus* (Finnish), *Praktcissus* (Swedish), and Rex begonia vine.

*Javana* means 'of or from Java (Indonesia)'.

Begonia treebine is cultivated as an ornamental plant.
