*Corydalis lutea*

[Synonyms : *Fumaria capnoides*, *Fumaria lutea*, *Pseudofumaria lutea*]

**YELLOW CORYDALIS** is an evergreen perennial (often grown as an annual). Native to southern Europe it has small short-spurred, yellow flowers.

It is also known as *Chocholačka* (Slovak), *Chocholačka žlutá* (Czech), *Dymnivka žlutá* (Czech), *Gelber Lerchensporn* (German), *Gul nunneört* (Swedish), Hollowort, *Keltakiurunkannus* (Finnish), *Mwg y Ddaear Melyn* (Welsh), Rock fumewort, and Yellow fumitory.

The flowers all face in the same direction.

Warning – all parts of the plant can be poisonous. It can be poisonous for animals.

*Lutea* means ‘deep yellow’ with reference to the flowers.
