Cucumis melo var. *dudaim*

POMEGRANATE MELON is a vine. It is native to Iran.

It is also known as *Abûsh shammâm* (Arabic), *Ägyptische melone* (German), *Apfelmelone* (German), Apple melon, Canary melon, *Cetriuolo odoroso* (Italian), *Cocomero melo* (Italian), *Concombre dudaim* (French), Dudaim melon, Fragrant melon, *Melon dudaim* (French), *Melon égyptien* (French), Plum granny, Pocket melon, *Poponcino d'Egitto* (Italian), *Popone odoroso* (Italian), Queen Anne's pocket melon, *Shamam* (Turkish), *Shammâm* (Arabic), *Shammâm afrangî* (Arabic), Stink melon, Vine pomegranate, and *Yaylagic* (Turkish).

Melo is Latin (apple-shaped melon).
