Dactylorhiza viridis

[Synonyms : *Coeloglossum bracteatum*, *Coeloglossum vaillantii*, *Coeloglossum viride*, *Coeloglossum viride* subsp. *bracteatum*, *Gymnadenia viridis*, *Habenaria viridis*, *Orchis viridis*, *Platanthera viridis*, *Satyrium alpinum*, *Satyrium viridis*]

FROG ORCHID is an orchid. Native to northern temperate regions it has short greenish-yellow spurred, red-brown tinged, yellowish-green flowers with a strap-shaped brownish-green lip.

It is also known as Frog-bit orchis, *Groene nachtorchis* (Dutch), *Grönkulla* (Swedish), *Grönyxne* (Swedish), *Grüne Hohlzunge* (German), Long-bract frog orchid, Long-bract green orchis, *Orchis grenouille* (French), *Orchis vert* (French), *Paladr Blodeuwyrdd* (Welsh), *Testicolo di volpe* (Italian), and *Vemeniček zelený* (Czech).

Viridis is Latin (green).
