Dalbergia stevensonii

HONDURAS ROSEWOOD is a tree. It is native to Belize.

It is also known as *Honduras Rosenholz* (German), *Palisandro de Honduras* (Spanish), *Palissandre du Honduras* (French), and Rosewood of British Honduras.

Apart from musical instruments (for which it is used on a commercial scale today, especially marimbas and xylophones, and the turning pegs on violins) the wood has also been used for veneering and turning generally, and for making furniture, knife handles and the backs of brushes.
