Dimorphotheca sinuata

[Synonyms : *Dimorphotheca aurantiaca*, *Dimorphotheca calendulacea*, *Dimorphotheca dentata*, *Dimorphotheca integrifolia*, *Dimorphotheca pseudo-aurantiaca*, *Osteospermum sinuata*]

STAR-OF-THE-VELDT is a perennial. Native to South Africa it has daisy-like, dark-centred, white to orange-yellow flowers.

It is also known as African daisy, Cape marigold, Glandular Cape marigold, Namaqualand daisy, *Solvisare* (Swedish), and Sun marigold.

Sinuata means ‘wavy-edged’ with reference to the leaves.

It is believed that Star-of-the-veldt had been introduced to Europe by 1774.
