Dioscoreophyllum cumminsii

[Synonyms : *Dioscoreophyllum klaineianum*, *Dioscoreophyllum strigosum*, *Rhopalandria cumminsii*]

SERENDIPITY BERRY is native to tropical west Africa.

Sweetener extracted from these berries is understood to be 3,000 times greater than that from the same weight of sucrose. Current tests indicate the likelihood that it could be a viable replacement for sucrose in low calorie drinks and foods.

The fruit are used by the food industry as a commercial sweetener.
