*Ericameria laricifolia*

[Synonyms : *Bigelowia nelsonii*, *Bigelowia veneta*, *Chrysoma laricifolia*, *Ericameria nelsonii*, *Haplopappus laricifolius*]

**TURPENTINE BUSH** is an aromatic evergreen shrub. Native to south-western United States and northern Mexico, it has aromatic, small needle-like, bright green leaves and clusters of bright yellow flowerheads.

It is also known as *Ericameria*, Larchleaf golden weed, and Turpentine brush.

*Laricifolia* is made up of the genus name *Larix* and Latin *-folia* (leaved) components meaning 'larch-leaved'.

Medicinally, turpentine bush has been used locally to treat dysentery, and various urinary and bowel disorders.
