*Gaylussacia frondosa*

[Synonyms : *Adnaria frondosa*, *Decachaena frondosa*, *Decamerium frondosum*, *Vaccinium frondosum*, *Vaccinium frondosum* var. *lanceolatum*, *Vaccinium glaucum*, *Vaccinium myrtillus*, *Vaccinium venustum*]

**DANGLEBERRY** is a deciduous shrub. Native to eastern North America it has pale greenish-pink flowers.

It is also known as Bilberry, Black whortles, Blaeberry, Blueberry, Blue huckleberry, Blue tangle, Blue whortleberry, British bilberry, Dwarf bilberry, Huckleberry, Hurtleberry, Hurts, Tangleberry, Trackleberry, Whinberry, and Whortleberry.

*Frondosa* is Latin (leafy).

The small and juicy, bloomed dark blue fruit with their their sweet and spicy-taste are eaten on their own (raw or cooked) or with other berries in puddings, pies and conserves.
