Gaylussacia frondosa

DANGLEBERRY is a deciduous shrub. Native to eastern North America, it has pale greenish-pink flowers.

It is also known as Bilberry, Black whortles, Blaeberry, Blueberry, Blue huckleberry, Blue tangle, Blue whortleberry, British bilberry, Dwarf bilberry, Huckleberry, Hurtleberry, Hurts, Tangleberry, Trackleberry, Whinberry, and Whortleberry.

Frondosa is Latin (leafy).

The small and juicy, bloomed dark blue fruit with their sweet and spicy-taste are eaten on their own (raw or cooked) or with other berries in puddings, pies and preserves.
