Handroanthus Bignoniaceae

Handroanthus is derived from a commemoration of the name of a Brazilian botanist, Oswaldo Handro (1908-1986) who specialized in ferns and allied plants such as horsetails and club mosses ie. *Pteridophytes*, and in seed-bearing plants ie. *Spermatophytes* together with Greek *antho*- (flower). In the company of two botanist colleagues he carried out some research at the Botanic Garden of São Paulo, Brazil.
