Hibiscus moscheutos

[Synonyms : *Hibiscus incanus*, *Hibiscus moscheutos* subsp. *incanus*, *Hibiscus moscheutos* subsp. *palustris*, *Hibiscus moscheutos* var. *purpurascens*, *Hibiscus oculiroseus*, *Hibiscus opulifolius*, *Hibiscus palustris*, *Hibiscus pinetorum*]

ROSE MALLOW is a perennial. Found in north-eastern North America it has crimson, pink or white flowers.

It is also known as *Amerika fuyou* (Japanese), Breast root, Common rose mallow, Crimson-eyed rose mallow, Dinnerplate hibiscus, Frisbee hibiscus, *Fu rong kui* (Chinese), Hibiscus (English, Swedish), Mallow rose, Marsh hibiscus, Marsh mallow, *Mocsármályva* (Hungarian), Musk, Muskplant, Perennial hibiscus, Sea hollyhock, Southern rose mallow, Swamp mallow, Swamp rose, Swamp rose mallow, Water mallow, and Wild cotton.

Moscheutos means ‘musk scented’.
