*Hicksbeachia pinnatifolia*

**RED BOPPLE NUT** is a tree. Native to north-eastern Australia it has strongly and sweetly fragrant, purplish flowers.

It is also known as Australian rosenut, Ivory silky oak, Monkey nut, and Rose nut.

*Pinnatifolia* is derived from *pinnata* (a feathery arrangement of leaflets on each side of the common stalk) and Latin *-folia* (leaved) components meaning ‘with leaves in feathery arrangements’.

The nuts were eaten by Australian Aborigines.
