Hieracium aurantiacum

[Synonyms : *Hieracium brunneocroceum*, *Pilosella aurantiaca*, *Pilosella aurantiaca brunneocrocea*]

FOX-AND-CUBS is a perennial. Native to central Europe it has small dandelion-like, slightly fragrant, paler-centred, orange-red flowers.

It is also known as *Ängsfibbla* (Swedish), Arnica, Artist's brush, *Bouquet rouge* (French), *Boutique d'or* (French), Burmah-weed, *Charbonnier lugubre* (French), *Chlupáček oranžový* (Czech), Devil's hawkweed, Devil's paintbrush, Dirty Dick, *Épervière de Hongrie* (French), *Épervière des Alpes* (French), *Épervière orangée* (French), Fairy's paintbrush, Fireweed, Flora's paintbrush, Golden mouse-ear, Golden mouse-ear hawkweed, Grim the collier, *Jastrabník pomorančový* (Slovak), *Jestřábník oranžový* (Czech), *Jestřábník rudokvětý* (Czech), King devil, *Marguerite rouge* (French), Missionary weed, Orange hawkweed, Orange paint-brush, *Orangerotes Habichtskraut* (German), *Oranssikeltano* (Finnish), *Pirevire orangée* (French), *Pomerans-Høgeurt* (Danish), Red daisy, Red weed, *Rödfibbla* (Swedish), *Roi des champs* (French), Tawny hawkweed, and Venus's paintbrush.

The flowers are attractive to butterflies, bees and flies.

Aurantiacum means 'orange-coloured'.
