Ipomoea orizabensis

MEXICAN SCAMMONY ROOT is a perennial vine. Native to Mexico it has tuberous roots.

It is also known as Ipomoea, Mexican scammony, Orizaba jalap, and Scammony root.

Locally the tubers are made into gruel.

Medicinally, the roots have been used as a drastic purgative.
