Krigia biflora

[Synonyms : *Cynthia virginica*, *Hyoseris biflora*, *Krigia amplexicaulis*]

TWO-FLOWERED CYNTHIA is a perennial. Native to North America it has dandelion-like yellowish-orange flowers.

It is also known as Cynthia, Goat dandelion, and Twoflower dwarfdandelion.

Biflora is derived from Latin *bi-* (two) and *-flora* (flowered) components.

North American Menominee Indian hunters used the stem to help them imitate the cry of a fawn in distress in order to lure its mother within their range.
