*Manilkara*

*Sapotaceae*

*Manilkara* is a local southern Indian (Malabar coast) name that is said to have been reported in 1683 by a Dutch botanist, H.A. van Rheedee (1637-1691).

Warning – humans.

Sapodilla *Manilkara zapota*

Large doses of the bark and seeds are poisonous and can cause gastroentiritis.

If the wood is worked, its sawdust can be an irritant.
