Monsonia ovata

MONSONIA is a perennial. Native to south-western Africa it has geranium-like, yellow or white flowers.

It is also known as Dysentery herb.

Ovata is derived from Latin *ovum* (egg) meaning ‘egg-shaped’ with reference to the leaves. Medicinally, the plant was used locally to treat diarrhoea and dysentery.
