Myosotis arvensis

[Synonyms : *Myosotis intermedia*, *Myosotis scorpioides* var. *arvensis*]

FIELD FORGET-ME-NOT is an annual or biennial. Native to north-eastern Africa, and to Asia and Europe, it has tiny pink maturing to bluish-purple flowers.

It is also known as *Acker-Vergissmeinnicht* (German), *Åkerförgätmigej* (Swedish), *Akkervergeet-mij-nietje* (Dutch), Common forget-me-not, Common scorpion grass, Fieldmouse ear, Field scorpion-grass, Forget-me-not, *Mark forglemmigej* (Danish), *Miosotis de los campos* (Spanish), *Myosotis des champs* (French), *Nezábudka* (Slovak), *Nontiscordardimé minore* (Italian), *Pomněnka rolní* (Czech), Scorpion grass, *Tricotin* (Channel Islander-Guernsey), *Vergeet-me-nietje* (Dutch), *Vergissmeinnicht* (German), and *Ysgorpionllys y Meysydd* (Welsh).

Arvensis means ‘of or growing in cultivated fields or land’.
