Narcissus triandrus

ANGEL'S TEARS is a bulbous perennial. Native to western Europe (excluding Britain), it has white to bright yellow flowers.

It is also known as Ganymede's cup.

The flowers are pollinated by bees and butterflies.

Triandrus means 'with three stamens' with reference to the flowers (although the flowers in this species have more than three).
