Neslia paniculata

[Synonyms : *Myagrurn paniculatum*, *Neslia apiculata*, *Neslia thracica*, *Vogelia apiculata*, *Vogelia paniculata*, *Vogelia thracica*]

BALL MUSTARD is a hairy annual. Native to south-western Asia and the Mediterranean, it has tiny yellow flowers.

It is also known as *Almindelig Rundskulpe* (Danish), Common ballmustard, *Finkensame* (German), *Korndådra* (Swedish), *Neslia*, *Neslia comune* (Italian), *Neslie en panicule* (French), *Ohraruoho* (Finnish), *Řepinka latnatá* (Czech), *Repinka metlinovitá* (Slovak), *Rundskulpe* (Danish), *Tamarillos* (Spanish), Yellow ball mustard, and Yellow weed. *Paniculata* means ‘pyramidal flower clusters’.
