Olearia macrodonta

NEW ZEALAND HOLLY is an evergreen shrub or tree. Native to Australasia it has small daisy-like, fragrant white flowers.

It is also known as *Aro-rangi* (Maori), Daisy bush, Large-toothed olearia, Native holly, Tree aster, and Tree daisy.

Macrodonga is made up of Greek *macro-* (large, long) and *odonto-* (tooth) components meaning ‘large toothed’.

As a shrub New Zealand holly has been cultivated as a windbreak, screening and hedging.
