Ornithopus perpusillus

[Synonyms : *Ornithopodium perpusillum*]

BIRDSFOOT is an annual. Native to Europe it has white-veined, yellow flowers.

It is also known as *Dvärgserradella* (Swedish), *Kääpiölinnunjalca* (Finnish), *Kleiner Vogelfuss* (German), *Klovicker* (Swedish), Least birdsfoot, *Liden fugleklo* (Danish), Little ornithopus, Little white birdsfoot, *Matala linnunjalca* (Finnish), *Mäusewicke* (German), *Pied d' oiseau délicat* (French), *Ptačí noha* (Czech), *Ptačí noha maličká* (Czech), *Serradilla* (Spanish), *Troed yr Aderyn* (Welsh), *Uccellina minore* (Italian), and *Vtačia noha* (Slovak).

It is a protected plant in the Irish Republic under the Flora Protection Order 1987.

Perpusillus is a Latin word meaning ‘very small, very little’.
