*Paradisea liliastrum*

[Synonyms : *Anthericum liliastrum*]

**PARADISE LILY** is a perennial. Native to southern European mountains it has trumpet-shaped, translucent, green-tipped, fragrant white flowers.

It is also known as Branched spiderwort, *Lis de Saint-Bruno* (French), Mountain lily, St. Bernard's lily, St. Bruno's lily, Star lily, and Star lily of Paradise.

*Liliastrum* is derived from the genus name *Lilium* meaning 'like plants in that genus'. The perennial was introduced to Britain in the early 17<sup>th</sup> Century.
