Pedaliium murex

[Synonyms : *Pedaliium microcarpum*, *Pedaliium muricatum*, *Rogeria microcarpa*]

BURRA GOKEROO is native to India and has yellow flowers.

It is also known as *Anai-nerinji* (Tamil), *Barra gokhru* (Indian), *Farid-buti* (Indian), *Ghati gokharu* (Indian), *Gokru kalán* (Indian), *Kadava gokharu* (Indian), *Kathe-nerinnil* (Malay), and *Khasake-kalán* (Persian).

Murex means ‘like a murex shell (such as those found on snails or whelks)’.

Medicinally, the leaves have been used by Indian herbalists for treating rheumatism, and the seeds have been used to treat impotence and incontinence.
