**CHILDING PINK** is an annual. Native from western Europe to North Africa and the Canary Islands it has tiny, pink or purplish flowers framed by papery brownish leaf-like bracts. It is also known as *Inukomochi nadeshiko* (Japanese), Proliferous pink, and Tubercle-seeded pink grass

The flowers are pollinated by butterflies.

It is a protected plant in Britain under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.
