Petrorhagia saxifraga

[Synonyms : *Dianthus saxifragus*, *Kohlrauschia saxifraga*, *Tunica saxifraga*]

TUNIC FLOWER is a mat-forming perennial. Native to southern and central Europe it has tiny, darker veined, pink or white flowers framed by papery brownish leaf-like bracts. It is also known as Coat flower, *Hvozdíček lomikamenovitý* (Czech), *Klippnejlika* (Swedish), and Saxifrage pink.

Saxifraga is derived from Latin *saxum* (rock, large stone, rock fragment) and *frango* (to break, break in pieces, shatter) components.
