Petroselinum crispum var. *neapolitanum*

[Synonyms : *Petroselinum latifolium*]

ITALIAN PARSLEY is a European biennial variety.

It is also known as French parsley, *Italienische Petersilie* (German), *Perejil napolitano* (Spanish), *Persil noir* (French), Plainleaf parsley, Plain-leaved parsley, *Prezzemolo napoletano* (Italian), *Silopersilja* (Finnish), and *Slätpersilja* (Swedish).

Crispum means ‘closely curled, finely or irregularly wavy’ with reference to the leaves.

Neapolitanum means ‘of or from Naples (Italy)’.
