Physospermum cornubiense

[Synonyms : *Danaa cornubiensis*, *Danaa nudicaulis*, *Physospermum aquilegifolium*,
Physospermum danaa]

CORNISH BLADDERSEED is a perennial. Native from western and southern Europe (including southern Britain, especially eastern Cornwall) to western Asia, it has tiny white flowers.

It is also known as Bladderseed.

This perennial is considered to be a vulnerable species in the wild in Britain.

Cornubiense means 'of or from Cornwall in south-western England'.
