Pilea nummulariifolia

[Synonyms : *Urtica nummulariifolia*]

CREEPING CHARLIE is a creeping trailing perennial. Native to tropical South America and to the Caribbean, it has minute pinkish-brown flowers.

It is also known as Creeping charley.

Nummulariifolia is derived from Latin *nummus* (a little piece of money) and *-folia* (leaved) components meaning ‘with coin-shaped leaves’.

This perennial is sometimes cultivated as an ornamental plant in hanging baskets.
