Pinguicula lusitanica

PALE BUTTERWORT is a carnivorous annual or perennial. Native to western Europe (including Britain) it has small, yellow throated, pale pink to pale lilac or lilac-veined, pale yellow flowers with pointed spur.

It is also known as *Fjälltätört* (Swedish).

Pale butterwort is self-pollinating.

Lusitanica means ‘of or from Portugal (Lusitania)’.

Insects caught in the hairs on the leaves are inexorably rolled up and partially enveloped.
