Pistacia texana

[Synonyms : *Pistacia mexicana*]

TEXAS PISTACHE is a semi-evergreen shrub or tree. Native to south-eastern United States and Mexico it has tiny dark reddish-brown nut-like fruit.

It is also known as American pistachio, Copall pistachio, Lentisco, Texas pistacio, and Wild pistachio.

Texana means ‘of or from Texas, USA’.

The plant is cultivated as an ornamental.

Birds eat the fruit.
