Poa infirma

[Synonyms : *Catabrosa thomsonii*, *Eragrostis infirma*, *Megastachya infirma*, *Poa annua* var. *exilis*, *Poa annua* var. *tommasinii*, *Poa exilis*, *Poa remotiflora*]

EARLY MEADOWGRASS is an annual grass. Native to Europe and the Mediterranean it has pale green flower spikelets.

It is also known as Weak bluegrass.

Infirma is Latin (weak, feeble).

In 1876 a Cornish botanist, William Curnow (c.1809-1897), identified the species in Cornwall in south-western England.
