*Poa infirma*

**EARLY MEADOWGRASS** is an annual grass. Native to Europe and the Mediterranean it has pale green flower spikelets.

It is also known as Weak bluegrass.

*Infirma* is Latin (weak, feeble).

In 1876 a Cornish botanist, William Curnow (c.1809-1897), identified the species in Cornwall in south-western England.
