Polymnia canadensis

[Synonyms : *Polymnia canadensis* var. *radiata*, *Polymnia radiata*]

WHITEFLOWER LEAFCUP is a perennial. Native to eastern North America it has daisy-like, yellow-centred, white flowers.

It is also known as Bearsfoot, Leafcup, Mountain cup plant, Pale-flowered leafcup, Small-flowered leafcup, and White-flowered leafcup.

In the United States this perennial has been declared an endangered species in the wild in the states of Connecticut and Vermont.

Canadensis means ‘of or from Canada or north-eastern North America’.

The plant provided a toothache remedy for North American Iroquois Indians, and the Houmatribes applied a crushed leaf poultice to swellings.
