Polypodium cambricum

[Synonyms : *Phlebodium australe*, *Polypodium australe*, *Polypodium vulgare* var. *cambricum*, *Polypodium vulgare* subsp. *serratum*]

SOUTHERN POLYPODY is a deciduous epiphytic fern. Native to Europe it has green fronds.

It is also known as *Clach-raineach Leathann* (Scots Gaelic), Common polypody, *Syddlig stensöta* (Swedish), *Sydstensöta* (Swedish), and Welsh polypody.

Cambricum means ‘of or from Wales (Cambrian)’.

Southern polypody is a parent of several ornamental ferns.
