Potamogeton praelongus

[Synonyms : *Potamogeton praelongus* var. *angustifolius*]

LONG-STALKED PONDWEED is an aquatic perennial. Native to Europe it has submerged leaves and small, green flowers.

It is also known as *Langbladet Vandaks* (Danish), *Langblättriges Laichkraut* (German), *Långnate* (Swedish), *Liobhag Fhada* (Scots Gaelic), *Nykketjønnaks* (Norwegian), *Pitkälehtivita* (Finnish), Pondweed, *Rdest dlouholistý* (Czech), White-stemmed pondweed, and White-stem pondweed.

In the United States long-stalked pondweed is protected in the wild in the States of Illinois, Indiana, New Jersey, Ohio and Pennsylvania where it is considered endangered.

Praelongus is Latin (very long).
