Potentilla sterilis

BARREN STRAWBERRY is a perennial. Native to Europe and the Mediterranean it has small white flowers with with many stamens.

It is also known as *Aardbeiganzerik* (Dutch), *Coegfefusen* (Welsh), *Erdbeer-Fingerkraut* (German), *Mochna jahodovitá* (Czech), *Nátržník* (Slovak), *Potentille-faux-fraisier* (French), *Smultronfingerört* (Swedish), and *Sùbh-làir Brèige* (Scots Gaelic).

Sterilis is Latin (barren, unfruitful) meaning ‘infertile, barren’.
